

Handquilting - Beginning to End

These lessons will include a comprehensive review of the methods for making small, even and straight hand quilting stitches using the traditional rocking stitch.

The lessons study the stitch, choices of fabric and battings, marking your quilt, quilting on a hoop with discussion of using a floor frame and other tools that are helpful for hand quilting.

Supplies needed for the class:

- Scissors, small embroidery or thread scissors
- Thimble, bring your favorite or purchase one after the lesson on the proper kind of thimble for quilting.
- Quilting hoop, 14" (not an embroidery or cross stitch hoop)
- Mechanical Fabric marking pencils like SewLine. (Not a #2 pencil)
- 12" or longer ruler
- Required kit contains wool batt, cotton batt, blend batt, fabric and muslin pieces, and a stencil.
