





A Mystery Quilt by Debbie Caffrey  
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You have the option of making one of two sizes: a 60" x 84" large lap/twin size (44" x 68" before the border), or a 45" x 63" smaller lap size (33" x 51" before the border). The information for the larger quilt is given first. It is followed by information for the smaller quilt in parentheses. Choose the size you want to make, purchase fabric accordingly, and cut the pieces necessary for the size you are making.

The most important thing to remember when selecting fabrics for a mystery quilt is **contrast!** The fabrics should have good contrast among them in order for the pattern to emerge. Use color and/or value to achieve this contrast. *Avoid directional fabrics unless you are prepared to ignore their prints.*

**Fabric Requirements**

	<b>Fabric #1 – Light Background</b>	2½ (1¾) yards
	<b>Fabric #2 – Medium</b>	¾ (½) yard
	<b>Fabric #3 – Medium Dark</b>	¾ (½) yard
	<b>Fabric #4 – Dark</b>	1½ (1) yards
	<b>Border</b>	2¼ (1⅝) yards*
	<b>Backing</b>	5¼ (3) yards*
	<b>Binding</b>	¾ (¾) yard*

\*The border, backing, and binding may be purchased after the mystery has been solved, but more of the same fabrics may not be available.
